



Tachograph Training Course

In-person training in the Waterford Airport Business Park or Online training via Zoom

About The Course

The training course is recognised by the IRU Academy and is developed in full compliance with EU Regulation 561/2006, EU Regulation 165/2014 and EU Regulation 2020/1054.

Course Details

- Limited to a maximum of six participants for online training, while in-person training can accommodate up to fifteen participants, both options have a duration of one day.
- Online training does not include the practical aspect of using tachograph simulators. It is recommended only for those who are confident in their use of tachographs.
- Alternatively, in-house training allows for up to 15 participants and incorporates hands-on training with tachograph simulators.
- The course covers all aspects of tachograph systems, including driver's hours and rest times, working time directive, responsibilities of transport undertakings and correct use of the tachograph using tachograph simulators.
